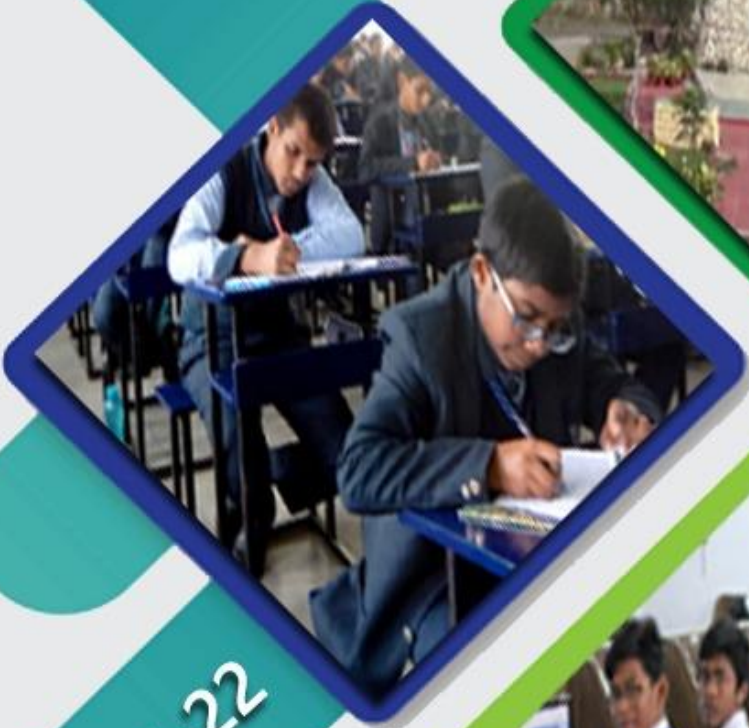

And miles to go before I sleep

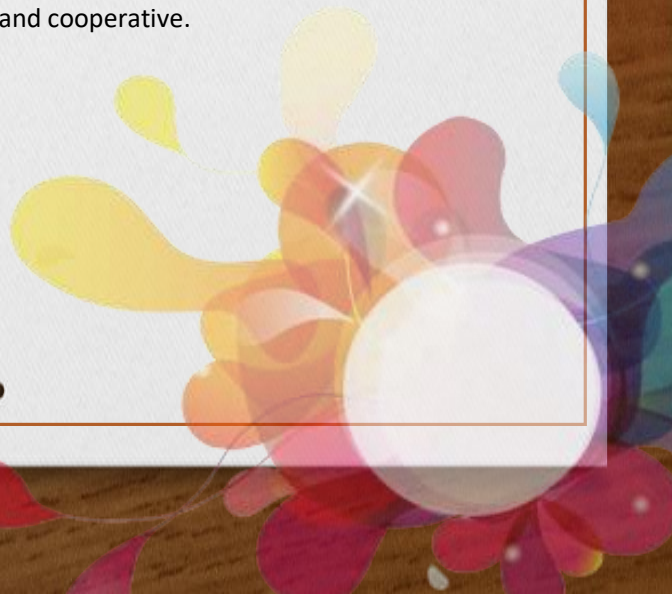

Adding another feather to the cap of achievements of Xavier School, our talented students have bagged prizes in the following events of “SHEEHAN FEST” conducted by KSMS School.

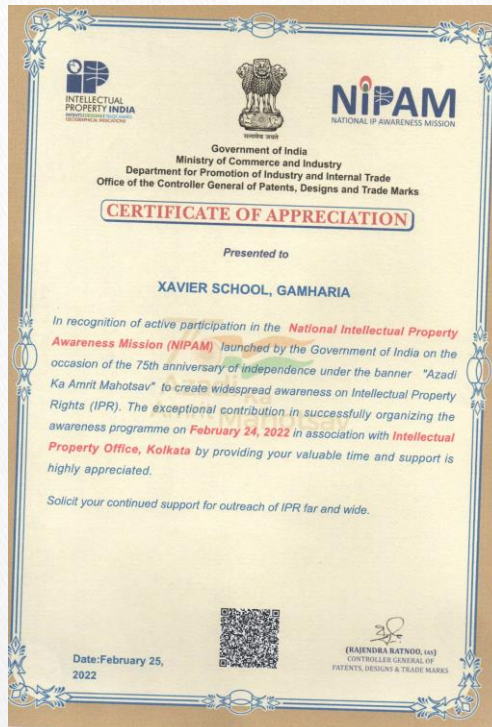

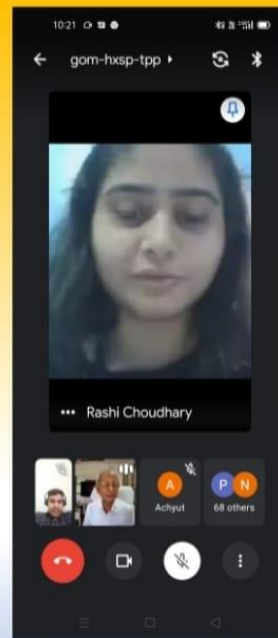


Fr. Alex G S.J. was the Chief Guest for the 73rd Republic day function held in school.

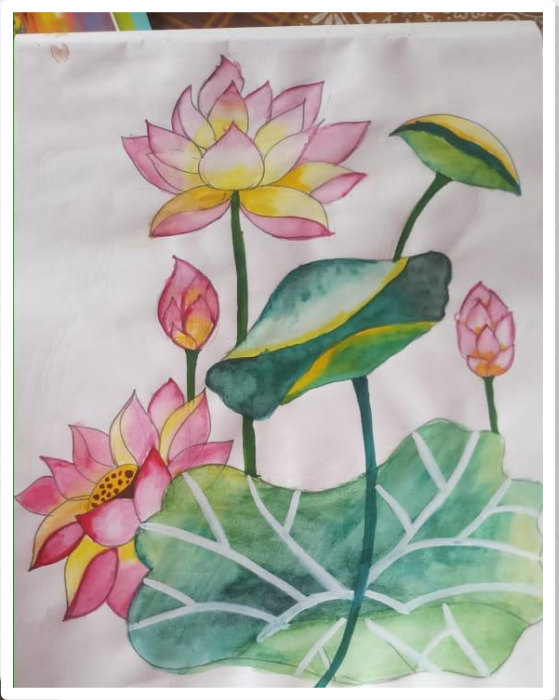


BLOOD DRIVE 2022

A Day for Our Constitution...

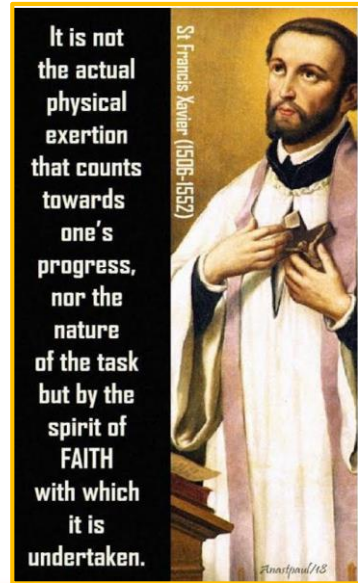

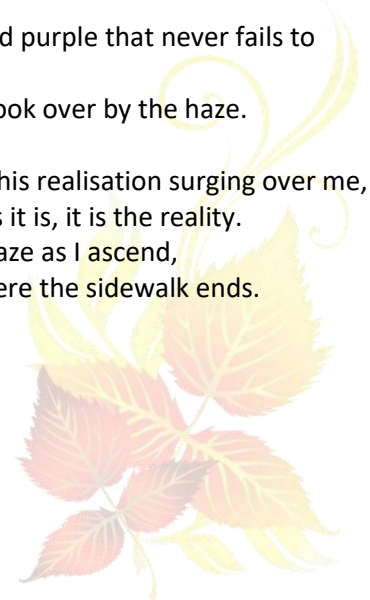

My name is Samridhi Raj Kumar and this is a true story from my life. I am a student of class X 'B' in Xavier's School, Gamahria. In 2021 April, I was diagnosed with fourth stage cancer which was life threatening. You can imagine what my family and I must have gone through emotionally. The word cancer is enough to get goose bumps, let alone bear the expenses of the treatment. Moreover, there is no certain date to when the treatment would end. And even if it does end, there's no certainty if I would get rid of this illness after the treatment is complete.



However, there's a profound quote which says that prayers reach where medicine cannot. Believing in this quote and having faith in God, my parents and elder brother instilled confidence in me. They made me believe that I can do it. I had to undergo fifteen chemotherapy sessions which were extremely painful with side effects. Furthermore, I also contacted the Corona virus twice where I had to stay in the hospital's Covid ward all by myself while battling Cancer.

In all of this, I kept going and used my free time to sketch and do charcoal art. Moreover, I created a Facebook page where I upload and share my sketches. I stayed in Mumbai for nine months where I was recognised as a Cancer warrior and met artists who appreciated my sketches. They also encouraged me to continue with my sketches as long as I could.

During this time, my mother stood by me as a strong pillar of support who kept encouraging me. She prayed for me day and night and never gave up.

Once again I have to travel to Mumbai very soon for a checkup with my doctor.

Through this story of mine, I want to thank all my teachers, friends, family and relatives with all my heart. All of them has supported me through a difficult phase and lastly, I would like to add, "Cancer Opens Many Doors, one of the most being the heart".....

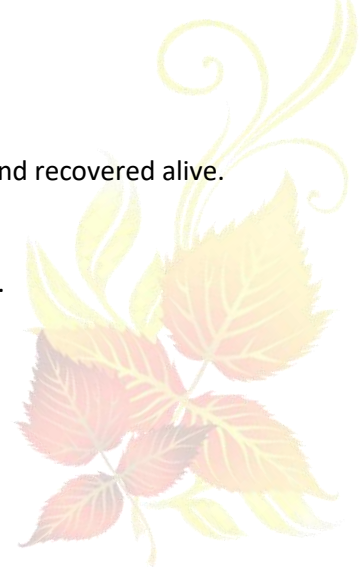

Physical activity, recreational events, positive thinking, optimistic approach, nutritious and balanced diet must replace social media, video games, binge-watching and the addiction of ‘always online’ to create a mentally and physically healthy society where each individual can thrive towards the positive side of life.

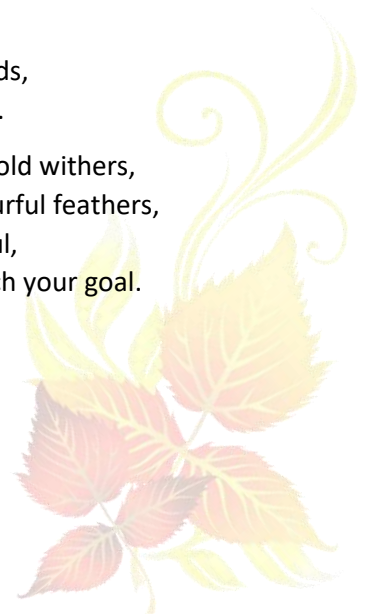

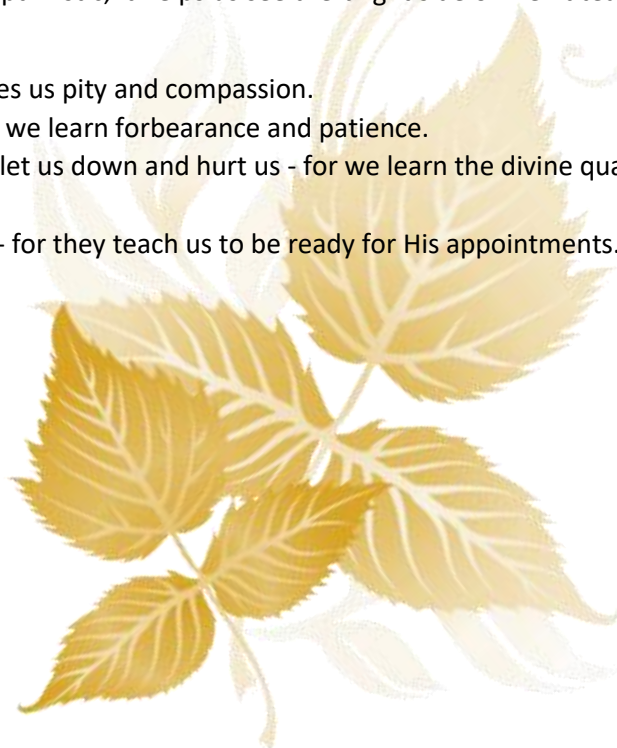
Let us thank God for sorrow - it teaches us pity and compassion.
